

Accessible Parking Nearby	<p>Please arrive in good time as many car parks may be busy.</p> <p>The closest accessible parking to the event is within Salt Lane Car Park. Other parking is available as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Barracks (come out onto Hertford Street to walk up) - Pool Meadow and Cox Street (incline up to get to viewing area) - The Belgrade Plaza <p>There will be accessible width lanes at all entrances. 	<p>description equipment, ear defenders and accessible seating we recommend you enter via the Trinity Street entrance, which has the shortest route to our Accessible Viewing Platform.</p>	
<p>Terrain</p>	<p>Along the routes from car parks are walkways with dropped curbs. Broadgate is almost exclusively paved and flat.</p> <p>The route from the Trinity Street Entrance to the accessible viewing area is flat with a ramp on two sides up to the platform.</p>	
<p>Access Kiosk & Access Stewards</p>	<p>Our Access Kiosk on our accessible viewing platform, on Broadgate (around the statue of Lady Godiva). Look for signage and City Host Stewards in green tabards. They will be happy to assist you.</p>	
<p>Queue Jump</p>	<p>You can choose how to enter the site as there are 3 entrances:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hertford Street - Upper Precinct - Trinity Street (Shortest Route to Access Kiosk) 	

<p>Audio Description</p>	<p>Collect headset from the Access Kiosk on the Accessible Viewing Area and walk down to meet your Audio Describer based on or near the ramp of the viewing platform. The headsets have a 30m range, but we recommend staying close to the AD, as you will have the same perspective to listen. Please return the headsets to the Access Kiosk on the Accessible Viewing Platform once the show has finished.</p>	 
<p>Ear Defenders</p>	<p>Please collect these from the Access Kiosk on the Accessible Viewing Platform – you will see signage held up by volunteers telling you when to put them on for one very loud bang at the end of the show. Please return at the end of the show to one of our stewards.</p>	
<p>Accessible Toilets</p>	<p>There are multiple accessible toilets available on site. Other accessible toilets are available elsewhere in the city centre.</p>	<p>Coventry City Council Accessible Toilet Map: https://www.coventry.gov.uk/accessiblettoilets</p>
