



JOIN US AS A COMMUNITY EVALUATOR

Coventry City of Culture 2021 will offer amazing opportunities to volunteer and give back to our city. As well as being performers, artists and city hosts, our volunteers will be activists and leaders in their communities, who want to bring about change. They will be people who love Coventry and who want to share with the world, all that the city has to offer.

We are currently developing our volunteering programme with partners but expect to offer experiences that include working with our producers to create programmes and events, opportunities to perform and participate, and training to become city hosts and digital volunteers.

Prior to launching our full volunteer programme, we are looking for four enthusiastic Community Evaluators to play an important role in evaluating the impact of cultural activity in local communities, across the city.

You will be working within communities undertaking surveys, conducting face-to-face interviews, collecting other data, and developing your own evaluation methods to assess the impact of the work being undertaken. Full training will be provided at the start of the programme and you will be mentored throughout the process by the wider evaluation team at City of Culture Trust.

You will be working with an Associate Producer and a partner organisation in tackling a specific issue within the city (poverty and homelessness, young people and criminal exploitation, integrating new communities, mental health and wellbeing) and will play an important role in monitoring the effectiveness and changes within participants, audience members and communities. We are seeking individuals who are:

- **Personable and friendly** and able to relate to a wide range of participants
- **Good communicators and happy to sensitively approach**, and talk to, a wide range of individuals
- **Knowledgeable of the cultural work** taking place in Coventry and be excited about the creative programme being developed by the Associate Producer
- **Reliable, accurate and able to follow directions** and pay attention to detail
- **Flexible** and able to commit to 1-2 days a month

We are seeking individuals from a wide range of backgrounds and we want to remove all barriers to taking part in this project. If you are currently in employment and would like to take part in this opportunity, we can have discussions with your employer to help in facilitating participation.

This is a voluntary role but, Coventry City of Culture Trust will pay reasonable expenses for your participation.

We will be trialling these roles for an initial period of three months, but we envisage these roles being in place to the end of 2021.
